### WHO TAKES OUR TOURS?

We provide the tours to students and their teachers (grades 5-12) as well as other organized groups from the local community (seniors, service clubs). In 2008-2009 school year, we had more than 5,000 students and teachers take the tours.

### WHEN ARE THE TOURS SCHEDULED?

The tours will start in September and will be scheduled on any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday of any week. The tours start at 9:30 am and end at 12:00 pm with tour guides needing to arrive by 9:15 am and leave after seeing the tour groups to their buses by 12:00 pm.

### WHO ARE OUR TOUR GUIDES?

The tour guides are volunteers from the community. Tour guides are not paid for their services. However, parking validation is provided (for parking in the garage in the Bank of America building at 300 S. 4th St.) Project REAL's offices are located at 310 S. 4th (our doorway opens onto the sidewalk directly outside the entrance to the garage).

### HOW OFTEN WILL TOUR GUIDES BE NEEDED?

Tour guides are welcome to volunteer throughout the school year as their schedule permits. For attorneys, this activity qualifies as pro bono service under NSC rule.

### HOW CAN YOU VOLUNTEER TO BE A TOUR GUIDE?

Project REAL offers regular trainings for new tour guides on Mondays between 9:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. To schedule a one-two hour training session, simply look at your calendar and see what MONDAY you can do it. The training start time can be 10:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m. (I do have an opening on Mon., Sept. 14 at 10:00 a.m. if you would like to join me as I train a couple other volunteers.)
